Application Form and Eligibility Criterion of India Continental Award

Applicants must be:

- *a)* Currently enrolled in any undergraduate degree seeking program <u>and</u> be either at sophomore or junior year status (senior students do not qualify) at Coppin State University. Also, applicant should remain full time students during the award academic year.
- b) At least 3.5 GPA
- *c) Must have an appreciation of all cultures.*
- *d)* Preference will be given to students who are on student visa at Coppin State University. Students with permanent resident visa or US citizenship may apply.
- e) This award is one-time award. Previously funded cases from this award do not qualify.

Awards vary in amount ranging from \$100 - \$500. Application deadline with documentation is due by Second Week of Spring Semester each academic year for full consideration. Decision made by the India Continental Award committee is final *and cannot be challenged*.
