

Install Tegrity Recording Software

Tegrity recording software allows instructors to easily record class lectures, so that students can replay the lectures later to enhance their learning. Coppin has a site license for Tegrity, which allows instructors to install Tegrity on their home computers or laptops.

If you recorded with Tegrity prior to November 15, 2015, you will need to install the newest version of Tegrity.

- 1. Login to Blackboard: http://eaglebb.coppin.edu
- 2. Click the link for a course that you are teaching.
- 3. Click the **Tegrity Classes** link on the navigational menu.



4. Click the Start a Recording button. This will prompt the software installation process.

5. Launch the software installation process by clicking the **Tegrity Recorder Installation** link. When promoted, **run** the file.





6. If a Security Warning dialog box opens, click Allow or Install to install the Tegrity software.



- 7. The **Preparing for Tegrity Recording** dialog box will appear while Tegrity is installed. This may take from 5 to 20 minutes, depending on the speed of your Internet connection.
- 8. Once the software has successfully installed, the Tegrity Recorder dialog will appear.
